Low-grade squamous intraepithelial lesion. Low-grade squamous intraepithelial lesion (LSIL) in the cervix is most commonly flat, but may rarely be exophytic (Fig. 1). Flat LSIL is characterized by dysplasia in the lower one third of the epithelium and/or HPV cytopathic effect.

Myomas may contribute to infertility by distorting the fallopian tube or endometrial cavity; if located

in the lower uterine segment or cervix, the tumor may interfere with normal vaginal delivery. Because of the increased estrogen during pregnancy, the tumor may grow and bleed within, causing pain.

Pathology The majority of cervical cancers are squamous-cell carcinomas. These lesions arise from the squamocolumnar junction and may be keratinizing or nonkeratinizing. Various methods of histologic grading have been used for cervical squamous-cell carcinoma, but these have no significant impact on prognosis [5,6].

Signet-ring cell morphology can be observed in both benign and malignant lesions of the uterine cervix. Most of the malignant lesions are metastatic.
