4. Narrative Poetry. Definition: As the name suggests, narrative poems essentially tell a story. As poems were easier to commit to memory, narrative poetry has its origins in oral traditions. This form employs literary devices, often regular metre, to tell a story frequently in the voice of a narrator and/or the characters in the tale. Features:
