The DPGP consists of multiple parts: 1. Self-Assessment of all 23 elements (classroom) or 11 elements (instructional support) from all four Domains 2.

• Deliberate Practice is a percentage of the Instructional Practice Score • Performance in Deliberate Practice can be punitive if the teacher shows no growth. • Top scores are not possible without growth in Deliberate Practice • Reward for high growth and high status score • More teachers will rank lower on the performance scale 48

Teacher Development Through Deliberate Practice

August 2014. Professional Growth Plan, now known as Deliberate Practice. •Teachers will record their Deliberate Practice PGP's online in iObservation. •Teachers will choose 1-3 elements within Domain 1 that they want to focus on throughout the year. •These chosen elements are determined by the teacher. •Teachers will identify their chosen elements, and then forward them in iObservation to their evaluator for feedback.
