Grade Level Referencing with MAP Test Scores

A RIT score indicates the difficulty level at which the student is answering about 50% of the questions correctly. Although it is possible to score as high as 265 or more on the reading test and 285 or more on the math test, 240 (reading) and 250 (math) are typical top scores. What is the average score? RIT scores range from about 140 to 300.
