Addressing Dyslexia Toolkit | Dyslexia Scotland

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It is a tool used to help understand whether there is a likelihood of dyslexia, and whether further investigation should take place. 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Children with dyslexia should sit within the peripheral vision of the teacher so they can pick up on non-verbal communication. Clearly mark resources with pictures as well as words, and display a pictorial timetable. Have an alphabet strip on each desk and a number square on each table to cut down on memory work.
