Thoracoscopy combines the science of endoscopy (video-assisted surgery) with thoracotomy (access to chest, or thoracic spine). Utilizing thoracoscopy, highly skilled spinal surgeons have determined lateral (from the side) entry through the chest wall provides sufficient access to the thoracic spine to enable thoracic scoliotic curve correction.

Thoracic spine surgery is a viable option for several spinal conditions that cause mid-back pain. The thoracic spine refers to the upper and middle-back portion of the spine. It joins the cervical spine and extends down about five inches past the bottom of the shoulder blades, where it connects with the lumbar spine.

Spinal stenosis surgery in the thoracic region is a fairly rare procedure as narrowing of the spinal canal usually occurs in the lumbar or cervical regions of the spine. Where thoracic spinal stenosis does occur it can cause pain in the ribs and the back, radiating pain down the legs that can affect walking, and even breathing difficulties.

Thoracic herniated disc surgery is indicated in only rare instances when a herniated disc leads to myelopathy (spinal cord dysfunction), progressive neurologic deficits, or intolerable pain. Typically, these symptoms occur following an acute traumatic herniated disc with myelopathy. The thoracic surgery to address these symptoms, called a decompression, is designed to take the pressure off the spinal cord or nerve root.

Traditionally, spine surgeons performed thoracic discectomy through an anterior (front) or a posterior (back) approach. The anterior approach requires assistance from a cardiothoracic surgeon and may involve broken ribs and breathing tubes.

This may include patients with idiopathic scoliosis who have large thoracic curve ≥80 degrees, diminished curve flexibility (rigid curves), and patients that are skeletally immature (adolescents).
